## DETAILED INTINERARY 07D/06N

## Day 1 PLIMA

Arrival at Lima Jorge Chavez International airport and transfer to hotel in the Miraflores area



## Day 2 LIMA

09:10 Start of group day visit to Larco Museum and Lima city's historical center and modern districts. The Larco museum is part of an 18th-century colonial mansion where the largest and most impressive Peru pre-Columbian art collection in the world can be appreciated. Its new galleries display the best and most complete collection of Peruvian gold and silver together with its famous collection of erotic pottery.

After lunch, the visit highlights the 3 main historical stages of Lima city; pre-hispanic, Colonial and Modern. Settlement remains dated up to 200 ad, churches, mansions, modern buildings in San Isidro and Miraflores are covered through the afternoon.



## Day 3 CUZCO

Transfer to airport for morning flight to Cusco. After arrival and transfer to hotel, free time to start acclimatizing to the city's altitude of 3,400 m above-sea-level. Afternoon group visit to some of this city's most important sites, including Cusco's Cathedral, the Temple of the Sun (Koricancha) and the archeological complexes of Tambomachay, Qenqo and Sacsayhuaman.

Cusco is truly a fascinating place to visit, providing a blend of the two cultures (Inca and Spanish). It owns a look and a feel about it that is quite unique compared to the rest of Peru.



#### Day 4 MACHU PICCHU

Early morning transfer to Poroy station to catch the Vistadome train to Aguas Calientes. Bus up and private visit to Machu Picchu.

This New Wonder of the World stands at 2,430 m above sea-level, in the middle of a tropical mountain forest, in an extraordinarily beautiful setting. It was probably the most amazing urban development of the Inca Empire, which was never found by the Spanish conquerors. It was declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1,983.

Afternoon train back to Cusco, Hotel



## Day 5 PUERTO MALDONADO - TAMBOPATA

Transfer to airport for morning flight to Puerto Maldonado. Arrival and transfer to rainforest lodge. Activities in and around the Reserve.

The Tambopata National Reserve comprises 275,000 hectares of preserved land in Southeastern Peru. It has many diverse habitats, including lowland Amazon rainforest, riverine forest, and oxbow lakes. Three rivers: the Malinowski, the Tambopata, and the Madre de Dios, go through it

The Reserve has an incredibly biodiversity and is protected by law. It hosts over 1,000 species of butterflies, 100 species of mammals, around 600 species of birds, and hundreds of species of trees and plants, making it one of the most diverse areas in the world



#### Day 6 LODGE

Activities in and around the lodge.



## Day 7 LIMA

Transfer to airport for early afternoon flight back to Lima
