When you are having an online lesson please behave as you would behave in class.

LESSEN DISTRACTIONS

Make sure your workplace is free from distractions (away from other people and keep your phone away, or turn it off)



BE ON TIME

Be on time for the lesson - bear in mind that sometimes connecting online takes time



BE PREPARED

Make sure you have everything you need close to you (books, pencil and paper, calculator, other materials for the specific subject)



REVIEW

Review all teaching material before the class - check the Classroom site for work before the lesson starts.



USE ONLINE ETIQUETTE

- Stay on "mute" unless your teacher indicates otherwise or you want to participate
- Keep your video "on" - your teacher wants to see you participate



SPEAK UP & ASK FOR HELP

- Participate actively in online discussions and other learning activities.
- Don't leave the lesson with questions about the work you have to do - ask your teacher before the session is over.

SHOW RESPECT FOR YOUR TEACHER AND FELLOW STUDENTS

- Show respect with how you look. Be well dressed - no pajamas while on screen for the lesson
- No eating or drinking in front of the camera
- Please sit at a desk or table for a lesson. (Not from your bed!)
- You are not allowed to share the class code with others who are not part of the class
